Program of Journalism

ESJ Paris Distance Learning (EAD)

Academic year 2021-2022 (May and October classes)

The EAD journalism program consists of two years of distance education:

- a first-year "level 1," in which students receive training in basic concepts
- a second-year "level 2," in which students receive in-depth training that concentrates on employability

The program

The EAD coursework is identical to the coursework offered at ESJ Paris. The curriculum offers training in all types of media, including content creation in television, digital, communications, investigations, and interviewing, as well as the mastery of journalistic style for print publications.

Diplomas

The degree the student earns is based on the level of his curriculum upon entry into EAD:

- entry level Bac +3 leads to a Bac +5 (Master II of Journalism)
- entry level Bac +2 leads to a Bac +4 (Master I of Journalism)

Level of entry

The entry level applicable to each candidate is assessed by the admissions jury. In some cases it is possible, through the provisions of the French VAE law, a student may complete EAD with on-site classes and professional experience.

Validation

The student's work is evaluated each semester. The student may request a postponement of the following semester, but must justify the reason for the request.

To earn credit each semester, the student must obtain an average of over 10/20 and must have completed at least 80% of the coursework.
